

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that I have made a ground survey of the subdivision described herein and that temporary monuments have been placed as shown on the within plat and that a bond has been furnished to the City of Omaha to insure placing of permanent monuments and stakes at all corners of all lots, streets, angle points and ends of all curves in Loukota's Keystone Addition (Lots 1 thru 20 inclusive) being a replat of part of Lot 65, Keystone Park, an addition in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 3 Township 15 North, Range 12 East of the 6th P.M., Douglas County, Nebraska, more particulary described as follows:




