ORDINANCE NO. 63
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMYRA, OTOE COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Be it ordained by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of Village of Palmyra, Otoe County, Nebraska, as follows:

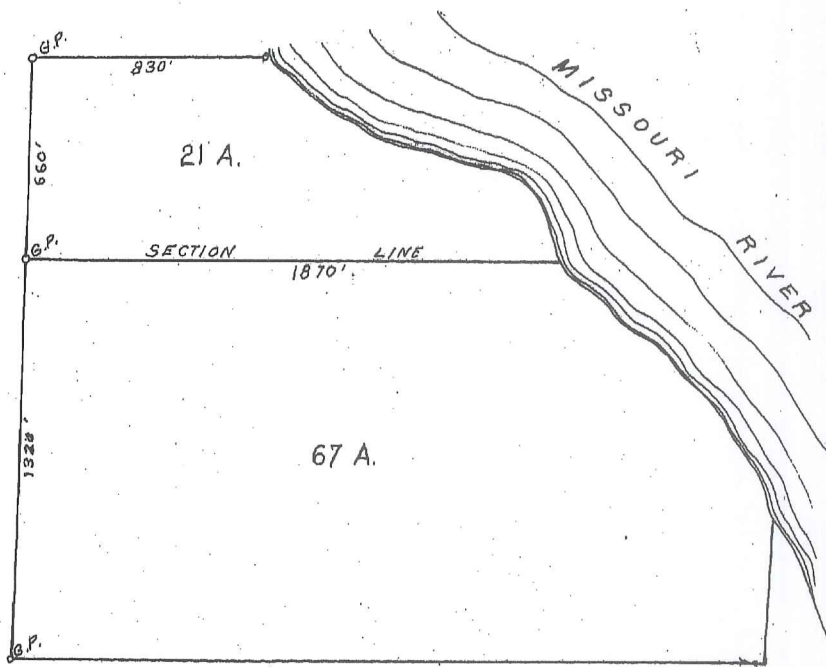
SECTION -1-

That pursuant to a decree entered in the District Court Otoe County, Nebraska, the following described land, adjacent to the Village of Palmyra, be and is, hereby included within the village limits of said Village, and the boundaries of said Village are hereby extended so as to include
