Sec. 35, T. 9, R. 9, Otoe County, Nebr. 80 rods North of the 1/4  
Sec. corner between said sections, thence north 40 rods, thence west  
160 rods, thence south 20 rods, thence west 40 rods, thence south  
100 rods, thence east 40 rods, thence north 80 rods, thence east 160 rods, to the place of beginning

containing 65 acres. X

Beginning at a point 140 ft. east of the center of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 34, T. 9, R. 9,, Otoe  
County, Nebr. thence northeasterly along the north right-of-way line of the Chicago, Burlington &  
Quincy Railroad 1460 ft. to the section line between Sec. 34 and Sec. 35, thence north 160 ft.  
on the Sec. line, thence in Sec. 35, T. 9, R. 9, easterly along the north right-of-way of said  
railroad 1330 ft. to the intersection of the N. and S. center line of the S. W. 1/4 of Sec. 35,  
thence south on said line 160 ft. to the S. right-of-way line of said railroad, thence in a  
westerly direction along the S. right-of-way line of said railroad 1340 ft. to the Sec. line  
between Sec. 34 and Sec. 35, T. 9, R. 9, thence in a southwesterly direction in Sec. 34, T. 9, R.  
9, 1250 ft. along the S. right-of-way line of said railroad to the E. & W. center line of the  
S. E. 1/4 of Sec. 34, thence west 165 ft. to the place of beginning, said tract of land being the  
right-of-way of the Chicago Burlington & Quincy Railroad.

Beginning at the N. E. Corner of the W. 1/2 of the S. W. 1/4 of Sec. 35, T. 9, R. 9, Otoe County,  
Nebr. thence West 794.5 ft. on said 1/2 sec. line to the N. E. corner of McKee's Addition to  
Palmyra, thence south along the east side of said addition 280 feet to the North right of way  
line of the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad thence easterly along the N. right-of-way line  
of said railroad 800 ft. to the N. & S. center line of said S. W. 1/4 of Sec. 35, thence north  
400 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 5.7 acres.
