

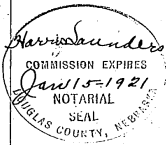

Metropolitan Water District of the City of Omaha:-

I, Charles W. Martin, the undersigned owner of the lots
and lands abutting upon portions of the following Streets,

towit: Vane, Whitmore, Ida, Titus, Mary, Newport and Bauman Streets and Redick Avenue between
24th Street and Minne Lusa Avenue, all included within Minne Lusa Addition to the city of
Omaha, being the record owner of a majority of the feet frontage of said portions of said
Streets, as shown by the generally recognized maps of the said City, do hereby petition to
have a Water Main District created including such portions of said streets, and that water
main be laid within the limits of said District as early as practicable at a cost to abutting
property of not to exceed 50¢ per front foot and I hereby agree and do waive all objections to
the levy of a tax by the Metropolitan Water District of Omaha to pay said cost, not exceeding
50¢ per front foot, upon abutting property in said District, and to any and all informalities
in the creation of said Water Main District, in advertising for bids for the installation
of pipe lines within said district, or in the installation of said pipe lines within said
Water Main District.

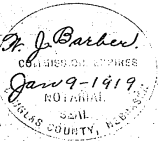
The said lots and lands belonging to me are as follows: All of the lots included
