ORDINANCE NO. 277

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TAX LOT 63 IN SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH, RANGE 9, EAST OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, WHICH IS CONTIGUOUS TO THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON, NEBRASKA, AND EXTENDING THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE TO INCLUDE SAID ANNEXED TERRITORY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That a petition has been presented to the Village of Arlington signed by all of the owners of Tax Lot 63 in Section 12, Township 17 North, Range 9, East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Washington County, Nebraska, requesting that said territory which is contiguous to the Village of Arlington be annexed to said Village, which said request was accompanied by a plat of said territory to be annexed certified by a competent surveyor.

SECTION 2. That a majority of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Arlington have voted in favor of said annexation.

SECTION 3. That Tax Lot 63 in Section 12, Township 17 North, Range 9, in Washington County, Nebraska, and more particularly described as:

Beginning at the quarter quarter corner west of the center of Section 12, Township 17 North, Range 9 East, and assuming the North-South quarter quarter line to be due North-South then South along the quarter quarter line a distance of 1141.50 feet; thence North 54 degrees, 31 minutes 30 seconds West a distance of 374.52 feet, thence North a distance of 923.0 feet to the East-west quarter line; thence along said quarter line North 89 degrees 47 minutes East a distance of 305.0 feet to the point of beginning, lying in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 12, Township 17 North, Range 9 East of the Sixth P. M., in Washington County, Nebraska, and containing 7.23 acres, more or less.

be and the same hereby is annexed to the Village of Arlington, Nebraska.

SECTION 4. The limits of the Village of Arlington are hereby extended to include said territory.
