This indenture made this lith day of April, 1930, by and between NEBRASEA POWER CCMPANY, a corporation hereinafter called "The Company" and Ernest W. Weiss and Martha L. Weiss, husband and wife of the County of Sarpy State of Nebraska, hereinafter called "Grantor":

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of \$5.00, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the Grantor, and the further payment of a sum to make a total payment of \$20.00 per hole for each and every pole set on the following described property, said sum to be paid as hereinafter provided, and mutual covenants and agreements herein contained the Grantor does hereby grat and convey unto the Company, its lessees, successors and assigns, the perpetual right, privilege, easement, authority and right of way to construct, operate and maintain its poles, electric transmission lines, wires, guys and other fixtures and appliances, over, upon, along and above the following described property, situated in Sarpy County, State of Nebraska, to wit:

North Half of SouthEast Quarter (Missi) Section Nineteen (19), Township Fourteen (14) North, Range Twelve (19) each of the 6th P.M., EXCEPTING therefrom, all that part of above description lying northwesterly of the center line of Chalco-Portal Drainage ditch.

The electric gransmission line shall be built of double pole construction, commonly called WHM frame construction, with a spacing between structures generally approximately 600 feet and not less than 300 feet. The poles of the individual NHM frames shall be set on ten foot centers, the

center line of said \*H\*\* frames being the east and west center line of section 19 aforementioned, this making one pole five feet north of and one pole five feet south of said east and west center line of said section 19.

The Grantor does hereby further grant unto the Company, its lessees, successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authorit; to enter upon and pass over said property and the property of the Grantor adjacent thereto for the purpose of constructing, repairing, operating and maintaining said lines and equipment upon the property above described.

The Grantor does hereby further granto unto the Company, its lessees, successors and assigns the permanent right rpivilege and authority to cut down or trim trees under or within Twenty-five (25) feet of the Company's lines, and to cut down or trim any trees or lims of trees on eigher side thereof as would be a 'mezard to said lines in breadking off and falling over or agianst said lines. All refuse or debris resulting from such tree trimming shall be disposed of in the follow's manner, towit: Cut main logs 6 foot lengths. Branches 12 foot lengths. Clean up and burn brush. Pile wood. Grantor will remove wood.

The Company shall at all times exercise all due care and diligence to avoid any injury or damage to the drops, livestock and other personal property of the Grantor and the Company agrees to imdemnify and save harmless the Grantor from any and all such damage and loss arising or occurring to such property soleby by reason of the construction, operation and maintenance of s id transmission lines.

## MISGELLANEOUS REGORD No.

The Company agrees that should the transmission lines constructed hereunder be abandoned for a period of five years, the right of way or easement ereby secured shall then cease and terminate, and this contract shall be of no further force and effect against the property hereinabove described.

It is expressly agreed that in the event the Company is unable to obtain a right of way by purchase, easement or otherwise over and across all of the intervening property, commencing at east line section 29-14-19 and ending at center section 23-14-11 so as to construct its poles, transmission lines, guys, supports and other fixtures and appliances thereon, then the Company shall notify the Grantor in writing of its inability to bbtain the said right of way and upon receipt of such notice in writing from the Company by the Grantor, this contract shall become void and of no effect and the Company shall be absolved from the payment of the further sum above indicated. The initial sum paid however, is to be the property of the Grantor. In the event that the Company is able to obtain all of the right of way between the points herein indicated, then the further sum payable hereunder shall be paid by the Company to the Grantor on or before the date of the commencement of the construction of the Company's transmission lines, poles, wires, guys, supports and other fixtures and appliances on the premises herein described.
