That for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Fred P. Curtis, of Douglas County, Nebraska, does hereby grant to Omaha Public Power District, a political subdivision of the State of Nebraska, and to Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, a corporation, jointly, and to their successors, assigns and assigns, a perpetual easement to erect and maintain electric and telephone utilities along, across, over and under together with any necessary overhang, the North 15 feet of the South 295.5 feet of the East 200 feet of the West 233 feet and the East 10 feet of the West 233 feet of the North 110 feet of the South 295.5 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 15, North Range 12, East of the 6th P.
