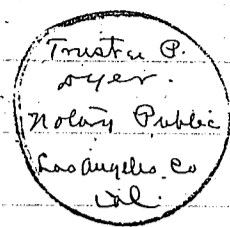

 bargain, convey and Quit-Claim unto Union Pacific Railroad
 Company subject to the conditions herein contained the following

All that part of 11th Street lying between the south line
 of Leavenworth Street and a line extending across said

 the Consideration therefor to be the sum of (\$2,500.00)

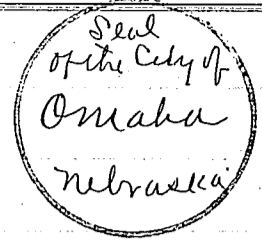
Also all of the west 44 feet of the alley in block

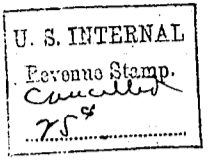
