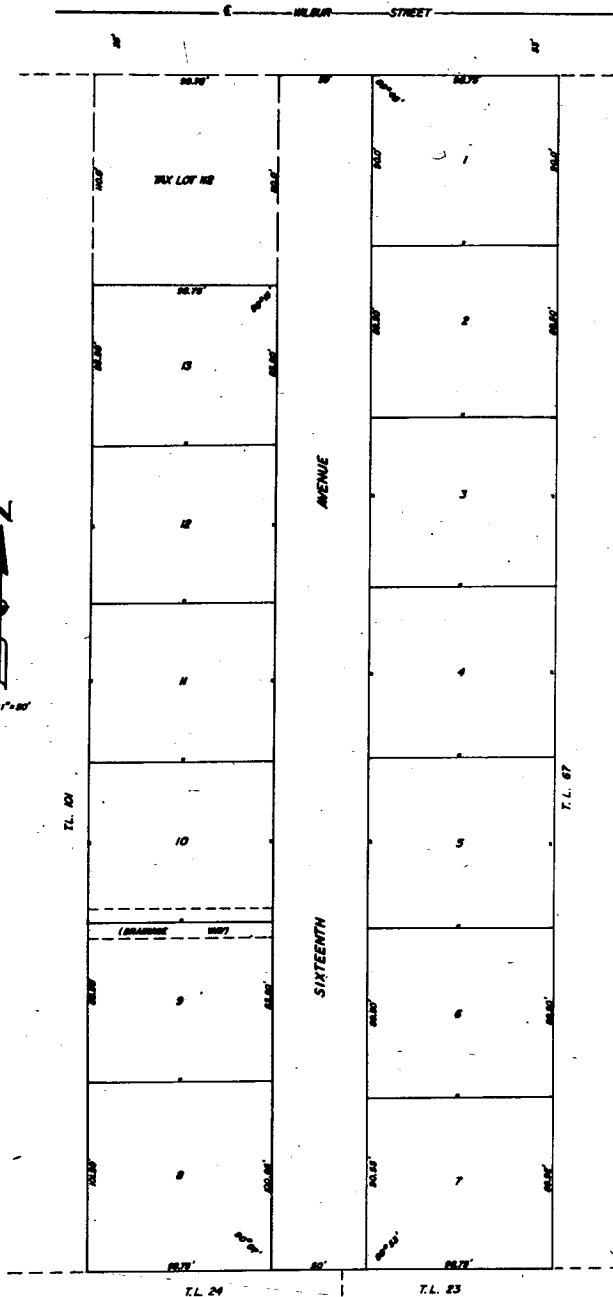


# THOMPSON'S TWIN ELMS ADDITION
