AGREEMENT.

WITNESSETH that whereas party of the first part is the owner of Lot 4, Block 39, of the Original Plat of the City) of Lincoln, and parties of the second part are owners of Lot 3, Block 39, of the Original Plat of the City of Lincoln,

and it is desired by said parties to give each to the other a perpetual easement for the maintenance of concrete footings for the foundations of buildings to be erected on said respective parcels of land by said owners,
