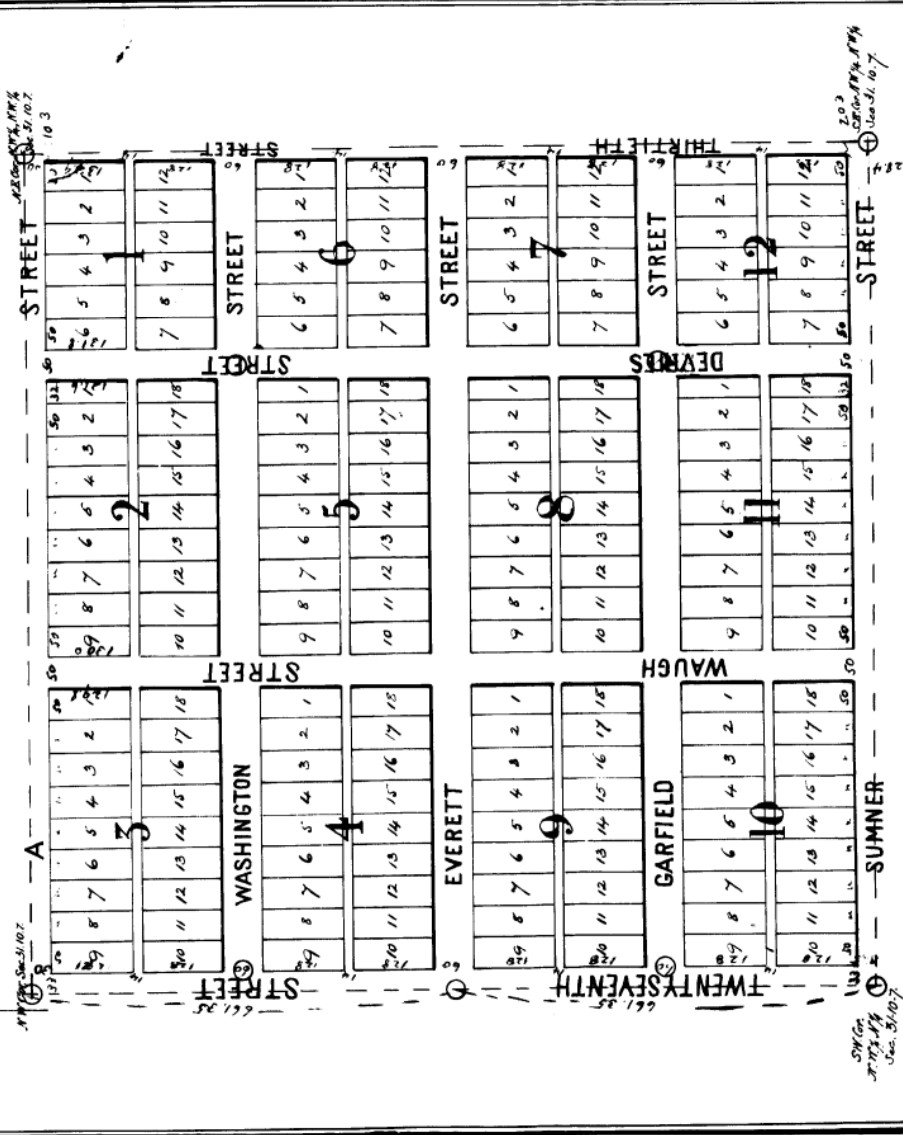


ZEBRUNG AND AMES

 I hereby certify that I have accurately surveyed and staked off the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 31-T10 N.R. 7 E into Lots, Blocks, Streets and alleys as shown by the above plat of Zebnung and Ames Addition to Lincoln, Neb. Washington, Everett and Garfield Streets are each 60 feet wide, Waugh and Deveres Streets are each 50 feet wide. A Street is 30 feet wide, 27th Street is 35 feet wide, Summer and 30th Streets have dimensions as marked. All alleys are 14 feet wide. All lots have dimensions as marked in feet and increments in real figures on the plat.
 Oak stakes are set at all lot corners on the block lines
