

RELEASE OF REVERSION.

WHEREAS, MADELINE JACOBSON and EUGENE V. JACOBSON, husband and wife, executed certain Protective Covenants dated February 15th, 1956, recorded February 17th, 1956, in Book 306 of Miscellaneous Records, at Page 731, which Protective Covenants among other things provided, "In case of violation of said Covenant referring to occupancy of property other than those of the caucasian race, said property shall revert to Madeline Jacobson", and

WHEREAS, said Reverter Clause has worked a hardship upon the owners of Lot 5 in Block 2, in Bel-Air Second Addition (Extension), an addition to the City of Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska, and the said Jacobsons desire to release said reverter.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES, and of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) Dollar, the said MADELINE JACOBSON and EUGENE V. JACOBSON, husband and wife, hereby release the above described property from the operation of the Reversion Clause above set forth, and declare said clause to be null and void, and of no force or effect.

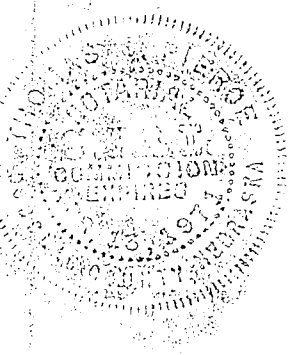

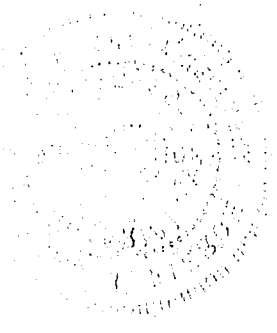
