

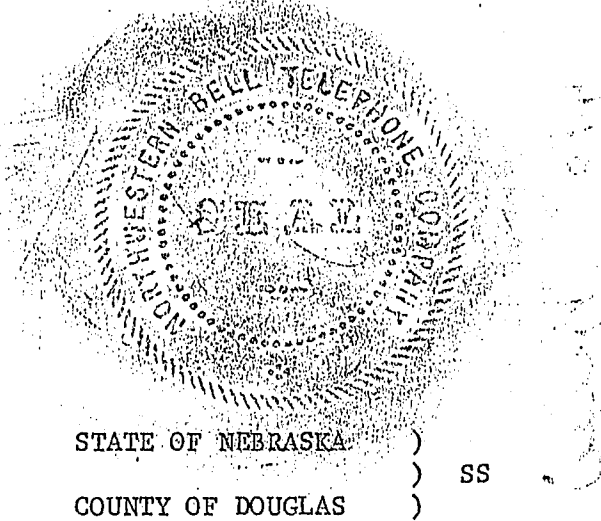
RELEASE OF EASEMENT

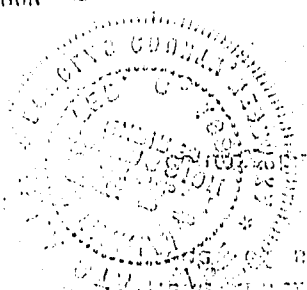
