REPORT OF APPRAISERS

Corm now the undersigned Appraisers, duly appointed in the above entitled proceedings to assess the damages that have been sustained by the owners and other persons interested in said premises, and do hereby respectfully report that upon subscribing the oath at the time and place appointed by the Court, and as required by law, we proceeded in a body to view the lands in the respective parcel involved herein and there fully informed ourselves in said matter, and heard the evidence as offered by interested parties, and being fully advised in the premises, we do hereby find, fix and assess the damages sustained by reason of the appropriation of a permanent

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casement and right-of-way for the construction, operation and maintenance of petitioner's electric transmission line on and across the parcels of land described in the petition filed herein and in the plats of said lands attached hereto, made a part hereof and incorporated herein and marked Exhibit A for reference:

## Parcel 1:

Description of Parcel - The North One-half  $(N_2^{\frac{1}{2}})$  of the Southeast Quarter  $(SE_{\frac{1}{4}})$  and the North Fourteen and Eight-tenths (14.8) acres of the Southwest Quarter  $(SW_{\frac{1}{4}})$  of the Southeast Quarter  $(SE_{\frac{1}{4}})$  of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Fifteen (15) North, Range Twelve (12) East, Douglas County, Nebraska.

Description of Easement - The centerline of the proposed transmission line over the above described property is as follows: Entering the above tract at a point on the East line Thirtyeight (38) feet more or less North of the Southeast (SE) corner of the North Fourteen and Eighttenths (14.8) acres of the Southwest Quarter (SWt) of the Southeast Quarter (SEt), thence Westerly and leaving the property on the West line Thirty-eight (38) feet more or less North of the Southwest (SW) corner of the North Fourteen and Eight-tenths (14.8) acres of the Southwest Quarter (SWA) of the Southeast Quarter (SEA), and also overhanging the West part of both the North Fourteen and Eight-tenths (14.5) acres of the Southwest Quarter (SWA) of the Southeast Quarter (SEA), and the North one-half (NZ) of the Southeast Quarter (SE1), all in Section Thirtyfive (35), Township Fifteen (15) North, Range Twelve (12) East; the centerline of the supporting structures to be located two (2) feet more or less West of the West property line.

Description of Transmission Line - The transmission line is generally described as a single pole wishbone transmission line, the conductor being supported on crossarms attached to a single pole located as designated on the Exhibit hereinafter referred to in connection with each tract number. Said poles are approximately 70 to 65 feet long. The minimum clearance of the lowest conductor at the crossarms is approximately 45 feet and in the center of the span is approximately 40 feet at 60 degrees Fahrenheit. The essement includes a right-of-way 20 feet on each side of a centerline, or 40 feet in width, and also includes

## Parcel 2:

Description of Parcel - Lots Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), and Fifteen (15), Bellair, an Addition to Douglas County, and Lot Sixteen (16) as shown in original dedication filed of record December 6, 1884, all in Section Fourteen (14), Township Fifteen (15) Worth, Pange Twelve (12) East, Douglas County, Mebranka.

Description of Essement - Overhanging the West part of Lots Eleven (11) and Fourteen (14) and overhanging the South part of Lots Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14), the supporting structures for said electric lins to be located Twenty-three (23) feet more or less East of the centerline of 74th Street, and Fifteen (15) feet more or less North of the centerline of Sevard Street, also the placing of two (2) enchors and down guy vires along the South line of Lot Fifteen (15) and the placing of two (2) anchors and down guy vires along the E.st line of Lot Sixteen (16), as shown in dedication filed of record December 6, 1884.

Description of Transmission Line - The transmission line with underbuilt distribution line is generally described as a single pole vishbone transmission line with the transmission conductors being supported on crossorms attacked to a single pole, and the distribution conductors being supported on separate crossarms: attached lower on said transmission poles with intersat distribution poles on the same centerline and bottom eath transmission poles. Said transmission and distribution poles being located as designated on the Exhibit hereinsfier referred to in connection with each tract number. The minimum clearance of the lowest transmission conjuctor at the crossarm is approximately 46 feet and in the center of the span is approximately 43 foot at 60 degrees Februshelt. The clearence of the underbuilt distribution will equal or exceed all applicable local, State and Mational Electrical Safety Codes. The easement includes right-of-way 20 feet on each side of a

centerline, or 40 feet in width, and also includes the right to cut down or trim any trees or limbs of trees under or on either side thereof as would be a hazard to exid line in breaking off and felling over or against said 11333

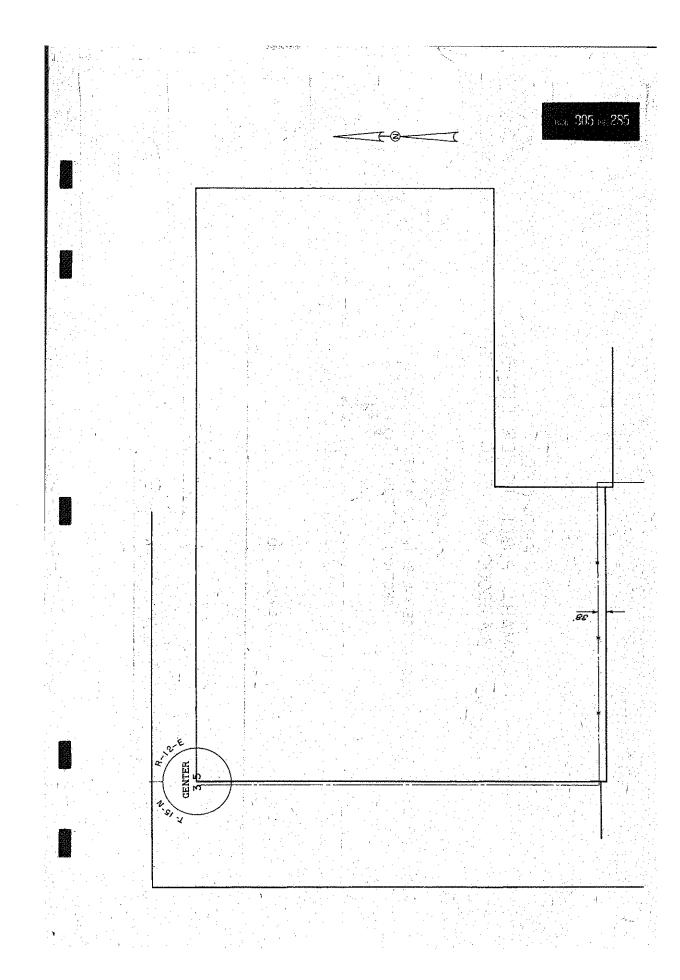
