

CONFIRMATORY DEDICATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that St. Lawrence Church of Scribner, a Nebraska religious corporation, of Scribner, Dodge County, Nebraska, did, on the 29th day of February, 1960, have legal title to and was the owner of all of Lot 2, Block 39, of the Seventh Addition to the City of Scribner, Nebraska, as platted and recorded, and being the record title owner thereof, does hereby subdivide and plat said land as shown on plat entitled "subdivision of Lot 2, Block 39, Seventh Addition to Scribner, Nebraska", recorded heretofore in Book R of Miscellaneous at Page 241, and on Page 318 of the Plat Book, in the records of the Register of Deeds of Dodge County, Nebraska, which plat is hereby incorporated herein by reference the same as if fully set forth at large hereon, including Lots "A" through "J" shown thereon and the north-south street identified thereon as a strip of ground 56.2 feet wide, and does hereby dedicate for public use by the public henceforth the street so platted, hereby reserving an easement in, on and over the rear five feet of all lots in said subdivision for installing and maintaining utilities, for the benefit of such utility companies and districts, including the City of Scribner, as may desire to furnish such utilities, all in confirmation of dedication shown on said plat.

As evidenced by the signatures of the president and secretary of said corporation affixed hereto, the said corporation does hereby accept the subdivision of the tract of land above designated and the street aforesaid as the voluntary act and deed of the corporation for the purposes set forth herein.

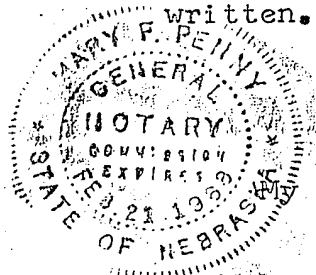

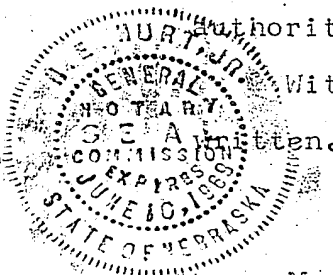

Wortmann, do hereby certify that I am and at all times since the 27 day of July, 1959, have been pastor, secretary and treasurer of St. Lawrence Church of Scribner, a Nebraska religious corporation, and now hold those offices, and at all such times have held and now hold custody of the minutes of the meetings of said corporation, and that the following is an exact copy of the minutes of a meeting of said corporation held at Scribner, Nebraska, on the 14th day of February, 1960:

"MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF MEMBERS OF ST. LAWRENCE CHURCH OF SCRIBNER

At a special meeting of the members and officers of St. Lawrence's Church of Scribner, a Corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Nebraska, held at St. Lawrence's Church of Scribner, Scribner, Nebraska on the 14th day of February, 1960 at 8:00 o'clock P. M. and all the members of the corporation being present either personally or by proxy and notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting having been waived by all members, the following resolution was presented and it was moved, seconded and unanimously carried that the same be adopted:

RESOLUTION

Whereas, St. Lawrence Church of Scribner, a corporation, Scribner, Nebraska, has the legal title to and is the owner of all of Lot 2, Block 39, of the seventh addition to the City of Scribner, and

Whereas the said St. Lawrence Church is desirous of subdividing said land into ten lots, the dimensions of which are 100 feet in length and 68 feet in width, said lots to be designated as "A" through "J" and

Whereas, the said St. Lawrence Church is desirous of dedicating for public use by the public a street located in the center of said Lot 2 and running from the north lot line of said Lot 2 to the south lot line thereof and being 340 feet in length and 56.2 feet in width, and

Whereas, the said St. Lawrence Church is desirous of reserving an easement in, on and over the rear five feet of all of said lots for installing and maintaining utilities thereon

Now Therefore, be it resolved that St. Lawrence Church of Scribner, a corporation, Scribner, Nebraska, subdivide said Lot 2, Block 39 of the Seventh Addition to the City of Scribner, into ten lots designated "A" through "J", in accordance with the attached plat thereof and Dedicate a street in the center of said Lot 2, said street being 340 feet in length and 56.2 feet wide and running from the north lot line of said Lot 2 to the south lot line thereof and that the said St. Lawrence Church reserve an easement in, on and over the rear five feet of all of said lots "A" through "J" for installing and maintaining utilities thereon. There being no further business to come before the meeting it was moved, seconded and unanimously carried that the meeting adjourn.
