

RELEASE OF RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that WILLIAMS BROTHERS PIPE LINE COMPANY, Grantor, a Delaware corporation with its principal office in ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Tulsa, Oklahoma, for and in consideration of \$1.00 and other valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby release, quitclaim and convey unto

JAMES L. KLEAGER and MARY E. KLEAGER Grantee,

all of its right, title and interest in the following and no other described real estate situated in Douglas County, Nebraska, to wit:

The Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section 10, in Township 14 North, in Range 12 East; not U.S.

acquired by virtue of that certain Right-of-Way Agreement executed by Janet Ellen Aycrigg and Edward Wilcox Aycrigg dated 4-23-46 and recorded in Misc. Book 211 at Page 191, and that certain Right of Way Agreement executed by James L. Kleager and Mary E. Kleager

dated 1-5-50 and recorded in Misc Book 250 at page 635 in the office of the Register of Deeds of the aforementioned county and state, in favor of Great Lakes Pipe Line Company and assigned and transferred to WILLIAMS BROTHERS PIPE LINE COMPANY by special warranty deed dated March 15, 1966 and recorded in Book 435 at page 667 in the aforesaid office of the Register of Deeds, it being the intent of Grantor to extinguish said Right-of-Way Agreement only insofar as it applies to the above described land.

By acceptance hereof, Grantees acknowledge and agree that WILLIAMS BROTHERS PIPE LINE COMPANY, its successors and assigns, are hereby released from the covenants contained in said Right-of-Way Agreement as to the lands herein released from the burdens thereof.
