LARRY E. LUDWIG, being first duly sworn, deposes that he is the Clerk of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 47 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, and makes the following statement regarding same:

1. District Number: 47
2. Outer boundaries:

The outer boundaries of SID 47 are the same as the outer boundaries of Park View Heights IV, a subdivision in Sarpy County, Nebraska (containing Lots 1 thru 118, inclusive) & Out Lot 1 also included in the District is Lot 1, Granville South, a subdivision in Sarpy County, Nebraska, and Tex Lot 2A in Section 15-14-12, Sarpy County, Nebraska.

3. The purposes of the District are to acquire, install, repair, maintain, renew, and replace a sanitary and storm sewer system, a water system, a system of sidewalks, public ramps, streets, and highways; to contract for water for fire protection and for resale to residents of the District, and to contract for and for electricity for street lighting for the public streets and highways within the District; to construct electric service lines, conduits, and gas mains, or to contract for the installation, operation thereof; and to acquire, improve and operate parks, playgrounds, and recreational facilities. In lieu of providing its own water system, the District may contract with a public utility district, municipality or corporation for the use of a water system and to provide water service for the residents of the District and for the use of the residents of the District.

The District has power to levy an unlimited property tax to defray its debt and its expenses of operation and maintenance.

The District is required by statute to levy special assessments on property in the District to the full extent of its taxing authority in order to defray the cost of improvements installed by it. The District may not levy a special assessment in any year when a budget is required by law, the annual budget is filed with the County Clerk, which budget includes the estimated revenue and expenses, mill levy, and interest on the District's debt.
