

NOTIFICATION OF EASEMENT

WHEREAS, Protective Covenants and an Easement were filed on April 12, 1954 in Book 287, Miscellaneous, Page 29, Douglas County, Nebraska, relating to certain lots in Alscher Homes, an addition to the City of Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska, and
