

RELEASE OF EASEMENT

FOR VALUE RECEIVED, NORTH WESTERN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY of Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska, does hereby forever release the right of easement for utilities installation and maintenance over two feet adjoining each side lot line of the following described tracts:

Lots One (1) to Fifteen (15), inclusive, Block 1, Lots One (1) to Five (5), inclusive, Block 2; Lots One (1) to Eight (8), inclusive, Block 3; Lots One (1) to Thirty-Six (36), inclusive, Block 4; and Lots One (1) to Twenty-two (22), inclusive, Block 5, all in Alameda Block, an addition to the City of Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska;

which easement is recorded in Book 297, Miscellaneous, Page 29, in the records of the Register of Deeds, Douglas County, Nebraska.

By release of this easement, the undersigned North Western Bell Telephone Company does forever release all rights which it may have acquired in and to said side lot lines by said agreement, this release being for the benefit of the present owners of said property, their heirs, successors and assigns. Provided, however, that the rights of the said North Western Bell Telephone Company in and over the side lot lines of each of the aforementioned lots are not intended to be released by this instrument and, except as herein expressly notified, said easement as recorded in Book 297, Page 29, Office of the Register of Deeds, shall remain in full force and effect.
