ORDINANCE	NO.	18477	

AN ORDINANCE extending the limits of the City of Omaha over certain land in Douglas County, Nebraska, and incorporating the same into and making the same a part of the City of Omaha, and repealing any and all ordinances insofar as they conflict with this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That the corporate limits of the City of Omaha be extended over and that there be included therein the following described land in Douglas County, Nebraska, which presently adjoins the City limits of the City of Omaha, as it now exists:

That area bounded by the following: Beginning at a point which is the junction of the center line of F Street and the center line of 42nd Street; thence Westerly to the junction of the center line of F Street to the East property line of the Chicago and North Western Railway right-of-way; thence Southwesterly along said right-of-way to the center line of now existing 45th Street; thence South along the center line of 45th Street to its junction with the center line of L Street to the now existing City limits at 42nd Street; thence North along the center line of 42nd Street to the point of beginning.

A map of the general area is attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A" and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance. The land is marked thereon, but said map is for convenience and in case of discrepance, the description in this section shall be controlling.

The said territory upon the taking effect of this ordinance shall be and become incorporated into, merged in, and be a part of the City of Omaha, Nebraska, and subject to the jurisdiction thereof and to its laws and ordinances.

Section 2. That any and all ordinances of the City of Omaha, insofar and only insofar as they conflict herewith, be, and they hereby are, repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect after fifteen days from and after its passage.
