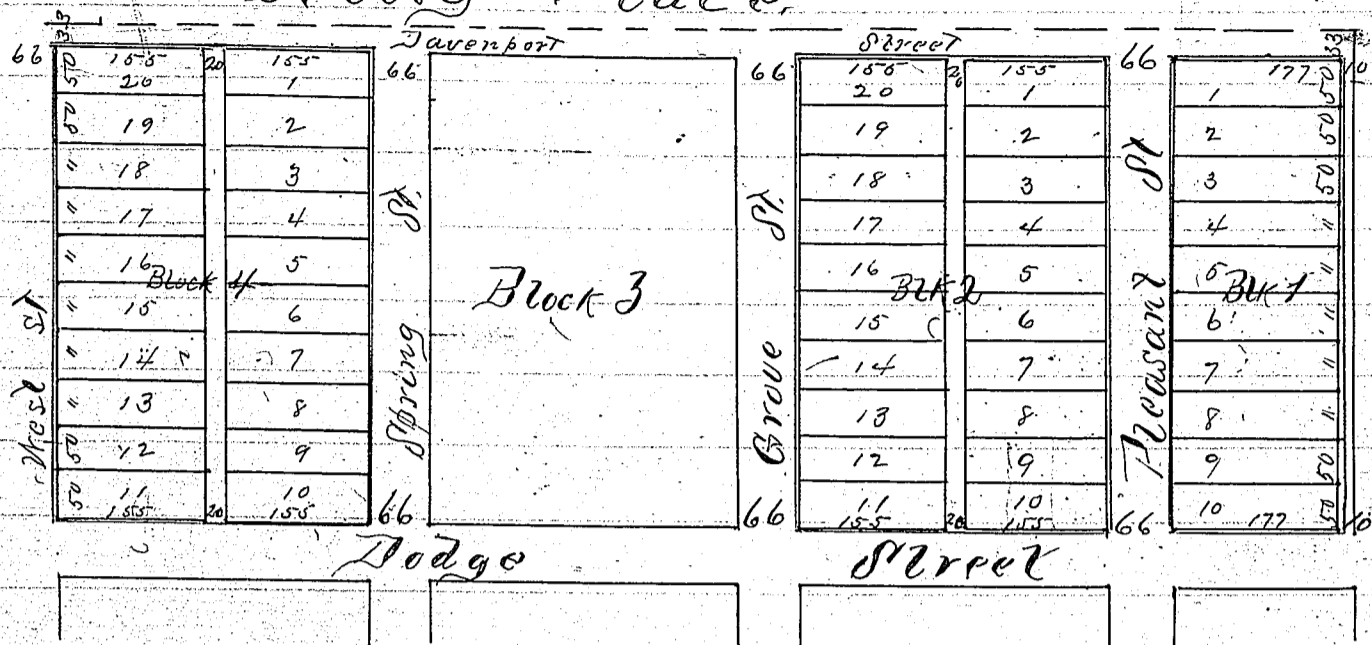


Blocks 1, 2 & 4.

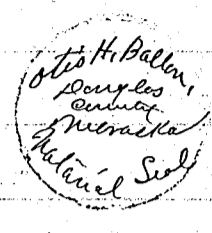
