A copy of such Notice is attached hereto as Exhibit "1". There are a total of 65 said lots.
- 3. That the actions taken by Affiant as stated herein were done pursuant to the approval and authorization of the Bellevue City Council.
- 4. That Affiant did receive written objections from those resident property owners listed on Exhibit "2", attached hereto and incorporated by reference, however such objections failed to meet the criteria set forth in said DOR in that said objections were less than 51% of owners of Avery North Residential Lots located south of Thurston Street and therefore, pursuant to DOR, the modification is made pursuant to the Notice attached hereto as Exhibit "1".
- 5. On June 28, 2013, a copy of this Affidavit has been sent via certified mail, return receipt requested, to those property owners listed on Exhibit "A" who have filed an objection.
- 6. All returned receipts are maintained in the records of the City Clerk.
- 7. Affiant has complied with all the provisions in said DOR for the modification of the DOR as contained in Exhibit "1".

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION OF DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIONS

Notice is hereby given by the City of Bellevue, Nebraska ("Bellevue"), a municipal corporation, the owner of Lot 153, in Avery North, a subdivision as surveyed, platted and recorded in Sarpy County, Nebraska, that Bellevue proposes to modify those certain restrictions contained in a Declaration of Restrictions dated March 14, 2011 and recorded in the Sarpy County Register of Deeds at Instrument No. 2011-07298 on March 15, 2011, by eliminating the restrictions on pavement and motorized vehicular traffic across the buffer zone established by said Declaration but only to the extent of that area of the buffer zone lying south of Sycamore Street, west of Lot 26 Avery North Replat I, a subdivision as surveyed, platted and recorded in Sarpy County, Nebraska, and west of a line extending south from the west line of said Lot 26 to the southern boundary line of the buffer zone and north of the south line of the buffer zone and east of Lot 139, Avery North as surveyed, platted and recorded in Sarpy County, Nebraska, and east of a line extending south from the east line of said Lot 139 to the southern boundary line and as depicted on the attached Exhibit A.

Such restrictions shall be modified as provided herein unless the owners of 51% or more of Lots in the Avery North and Avery North Replat I subdivisions located south of Thurston Street shall, within thirty (30) days of the date of Bellevue's mailing of this Notice, submit to Bellevue written objections to such proposal. Written objections may be filed by hand delivery to the address provided herein or by sending by United States mail, postage prepaid, to the address specified herein. Any objections filed by mail service shall be considered filed with Bellevue on the date of mailing as evidenced by the postmark appearing thereon.

Any objection should note your address and be signed by all owners of the property.


