Resolved

WHEREAS, on October 19th, 1907, a plat and dedication of Beckwith Place was filed with the Register of Deeds and recorded in Book 101 of Deed Records, at Page 200, and

WHEREAS, on May 18th, 1916, one Mary [Name] being the owner of said property filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Nebraska, an instrument attempting to vacate the plat and dedication of said addition, and

WHEREAS, said vacation was never presented to this Board nor accepted by this Board, and

WHEREAS, the public acquired a vested interest in the streets and alleys, as shown on said original plat, and

WHEREAS, all of the lots contained in said addition have been, and still are, assessed for taxation as Beckwith Place, and

WHEREAS, said attempted vacation is null and void, and

WHEREAS, Robert G. Hastings and Natalie H. Crowley, Trustees, the present owners of said property, have filed with the Register of Deeds a ratification of the original plat and dedication of said addition.

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Nebraska, that the plat and dedication of Beckwith Place, be, and the same hereby is, ratified and approved, and that the attempted vacation of said plat and dedication is now, and always has been, null and void and of no force and effect.

IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forthwith filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Nebraska.
