PETITION TO VACATE PUBLIC WAY
with
RELEASE AND WAIVER OF RIGHTS AND TITLE,
AND QUIT CLAIM TO CITY OF LINCOLN

TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN, NEBRASKA:

The undersigned property owner s hereby ask and petition you to vacate the following described street, to wit:

The west half of 72nd Street between Seward Street and the railroad right of way to the south.

in the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, the CITY OF LINCOLN, NEBRASKA, to reserve and retain in said street such title, rights, easements and privileges as it may deem necessary. In consideration of the vacation of the above-described street, we, and each of us, for ourselves, our heirs, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby waive and release and all claims, causes of action, title, rights and demands of every nature, known or unknown, which may accrue to us, or which we now have, or which we may hereafter have as a result of or resulting from such vacation of said street; and hereby remise and forever quit claim unto the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, and to its assigns forever, all right, title, interest, estate, claim and demand, both at law and in equity, of, in and to all of said street; together with all and singular the hereditaments thereunto belonging.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described street unto the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, and to its successors and assigns; so that neither of the undersigned nor any person in their name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof, but they and every one of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.

The undersigned hereby represent that they are the owner s of the following described property abutting on said street, to wit:

Lot 1, Block 3, Barnhill Acres, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

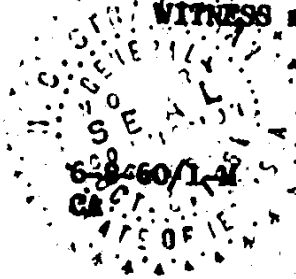
