AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION OF PROTECTIVE COVENANTS,
CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

The undersigned being all of the owners of all the Lots in Bishop Square, an addition to Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, do hereby amend the Declaration of Protective Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, dated April 5, 1974 and recorded as Instrument No. 74-5536, Register of Deeds, Lancaster County, Nebraska, and the Amendment to Declaration of Protective Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions dated January 18, 1979 and recorded as Instrument No. 79-4188 in said Register of Deeds, as follows:

1. Paragraph 2 of said Amendment to Declaration of Protective Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions dated January 18, 1979, is cancelled, annulled and of no further force and effect.

2. Paragraph XV of said Declaration of Protective Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions dated April 5, 1974, is cancelled, annulled and of no further force and effect and in its place is substituted the following:

"XV. Annual assessments shall be made by the Board of Directors of the Corporation for maintenance of the Commons and for the payment of the taxes and special assessments levied against the Commons and for purposes beneficial to the members of Bishop Square, Inc. and their individual properties in Bishop Square such as water and sewers, lawn care, garbage removal, snow removal, maintenance of a perimeter fence and security devices and services, and such other personal services and amenities that the Board of Directors of Bishop Square, Inc. may from time to time deem appropriate to the best interest and lifestyle of residents of Bishop Square. Assessments for capital improvements in Bishop Square shall require the affirmative consent of two-thirds (2/3) of all members. Such consent may be obtained in writing signed by at least two-thirds of all members or at a meeting called for such purpose in accordance with the Bylaws of Bishop Square, Inc. At any meeting of the members, every member may vote in person or by proxy.

3. The remainder of said Declaration of Protective Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions and said Amendment thereto shall remain in full force and effect.
