The Board met pursuant to adjournment. Present, Jacob Schram, Frank Kostal and Harold Ely. The following business was transacted by the Board:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the recent flood in the area of Sarpy County has caused extensive damage to roads, bridges and dikes in some areas of Sarpy County, and

WHEREAS, it is estimated by this Board that damage in the amount of at least \$200,000.00 has been caused as a result of said flood, and

WHEREAS, said damage is far in excess of the ability of Sarpy County to correct the damage caused by said floods, and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that Emergency Federal Assistance may be available through the Civil Defense Administration,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Sarpy County request that a study be made by the Civil Defense Administration or such other Federal Agency as may be appropriate, and that the Civil Defense Administration be requested to obtain Emergency Relief to correct and repair the damage to bridges, roads and dikes caused by said flood.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk of Sarpy County transmit a copy of this Resolution to Mr. Austin Bacon, Deputy Director of Civil Defense for the State of Nebraska, at Lincoln, Nebraska, with a request to Mr. Bacon that he forward the same to appropriate Federal Agencies to the end that Sarpy County may receive such assistance as is authorized by Federal Law to repair the damage caused by said flood.
