EASEMENT

The undersigned, hereinbefore called "Grantor", hereby grants and conveys to OMAHA PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT, hereinafter called "District", its successors and assigns, a perpetual right, without compensation, to enter upon and over said property, to construct, reconstruct, repair, and maintain the high voltage lines, conductors, insulators, crossarms, cables, wires, guy, supports and other equipment and apparatus used in connection therewith and conditions set forth, over, upon, along and above the property herein described.

CONSIDERATION

PRESENCE OF CONDUCTORS ON APPROXIMATE CENTERLINE OF EASEMENT (as scaled from aerial photograph)

The Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter ( $SW \frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW \frac{1}{4}$ ) of the West One-half of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ( $W \frac{1}{2}$  of  $SE \frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW \frac{1}{4}$ ) and fifteen (15) acres North of creek in the East, the half of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ( $E \frac{1}{2}$  of  $SE \frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW \frac{1}{4}$ ) all in Section 31, Township 16 North, Range 12 East of the 6th P.M., Douglas County, Nebraska.

Centerline Description:

Beginning at a point on the East line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 31, 216 feet South of the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, thence in a Northwesterly direction to a point of leaving located on the North line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, 216 feet West of the Northeast corner of said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 31.

Overhanging conductors only. There will be no structures placed on this parcel.

The wood pole structures to be set upon above described premises shall not exceed none in number, except that none additional wood two-pole "H" frame structures may be placed, upon an additional payment of per each additional structure, to Grantor, their successors and assigns.

Construction: The Grantor hereby grants to the District, its successors and assigns the right, privilege and opportunity to enter upon and pass over said property and the property of the Grantor adjacent thereto for the purpose of surveying, constructing, repairing, operating and maintaining said lines and equipment upon the property above described.

The Grantor hereby grants to the District, its successors and assigns, the permanent right, privilege and opportunity to cut down trees under or within 40 feet of the centerline of the District's transmission lines, and to cut down or trim any trees or limbs of trees on either side of the said lines so as to prevent damage thereto due to breaking off and falling over or against said transmission lines, all refuse or debris from such tree cutting and trimming shall be disposed of by the District.

The Grantor reserves the right to cultivate, use and occupy said land except that, without the prior written consent of the Grantor, no building, erection, structures, bay or screen shades, or other fixtures, furniture or equipment of any kind, within 40 feet on either side of said centerline.

The District further reserves the right to clear away all dead trees and other vegetation growing upon the property, which may become a hazard to the safety of the Grantor and the District, and to remove any trees or limbs of trees from any and all such damage and loss which may arise or occur to said property through the acts of God, fire, wind, or otherwise, and to remove any trees and vegetation of which may become a hazard to the safety of the Grantor.

This instrument is binding on the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of Grantor.




