AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by and between the Omaha Public Power District, a public corporation, its successors and assigns, hereafter referred to as "District," and the Omaha Home for Boys, its successors and assigns hereafter referred to as "Omaha Home for Boys".

WHEREAS, the Omaha Home for Boys is the owner of the real estate described on the attached Exhibit "A" (the "Property");

WHEREAS, the Omaha Home for Boys has requested that District provide electrical service to the Property and has specifically requested that the District construct, operate, and maintain certain electric facilities, including a pad mounted transformer ("the Facilities"), under, upon, and over the Property in the approximate locations set forth on Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, the District may require access to the Facilities from time to time to construct, reconstruct, maintain, repair, or replace the Facilities and constructing the Facilities in the locations requested by the Omaha Home for Boys does not allow the District sufficient access to the Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Home for Boys has declined to provide sufficient access to the Facilities by way of a hard surfaced drive.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The District agrees to locate the Facilities approximately in the locations set forth on Exhibit "B" and as requested by the Omaha Home for Boys without requiring that the Omaha Home for Boys construct a hard surfaced drive for access to the Facilities.
- 2. The Omaha Home for Boys acknowledges that the District has the right to construct reconstruct, maintain, repair, or replace the Facilities on the Property and that the District has the right of ingress and egress over and across the Property to the Facilities.
- 3. The Omaha Home for Boys acknowledges and agrees that the lack of sufficient access to the Facilities may impair the District's ability to reconstruct, maintain, repair, or replace the Facilities; may cause extended electrical service outages; and may cause increased costs in the reconstruction, maintenance, repair, or replacement of the Facilities. The Omaha Home for Boys further acknowledges that the Property may be damaged in the course of reconstruction, maintenance, repair, or replacement of the Facilities because of the lack of sufficient access to the Facilities.

4. The Omaha Home for Boys hereby agrees to reimburse the District for all costs and expenses incurred by the District in the reconstruction, maintenance, repair or replacement of the Facilities

FEEQO-SD 18 01-60000 BKP 6-15-13 C/O CO MY to the extent said costs and expenses are greater than would have been incurred had sufficient access to the Facilities existed.

- 5. The Omaha Home for Boys assumes all risk of loss or damage arising out of or related to electrical outages or the reconstruction, maintenance, repair, or replacement of the Facilities to the extent such loss or damage arises from or is related to the lack of sufficient access to the Facilities, and hereby waives and releases any claim against the District related thereto. The Omaha Home for Boys hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the District and its agents and employees, from and against all claims, demands, causes of action, liabilities and expenses (including attorneys' fees and expenses) of every kind, nature and description, arising out of or related to electrical outages or the reconstruction, maintenance, repair, or replacement of the Facilities to the extent such claims, demands, causes of action, liabilities and expenses may be related, in whole or in part, to the lack of sufficient access to the Facilities, except to the extent caused by the negligence, recklessness or willful misconduct of the District.
- The Omaha Home for Boys covenants that it has fee simple title to and lawful possession of the Property; good, right and lawful authority to enter into this Agreement; that this Agreement and the covenants contained herein shall run with the land; and that its successors and assigns shall be bound forever by this Agreement and the covenants contained herein.
