ORDINANCE NO. 1795

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE EIGHTEENTH STREET RIGHT OF WAY NORTH OF THE NORTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF WASHINGTON STREET AND SOUTH OF THE SOUTH LINE OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCKS 38 AND 39, IN THE CITY OF BLAIR, WASHINGTON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, RESERVING, HOWEVER, UNTO THE CITY OF BLAIR A PERPETUAL EASEMENT FOR UTILITIES LOCATED IN SAID STREET, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO WATER AND SEWER LINES, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLAIR, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Eighteenth Street Right of Way North of the North Right of Way line of Washington Street and South of the South Line of the alley in Block 38 and 39, in the City of Blair, Washington County, Nebraska, is hereby vacated providing, however, the City of Blair hereby reserves a perpetual easement for utilities located in said alley, including but not limited to water and sewer lines.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and following the passage and publication hereof as required by law.
