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E A S E M E N T

That in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other valuable consideration in hand paid us by grantee hereinafter mentioned, the receipt whereof we hereby acknowledge, we do hereby grant, bargain and sell unto the City of Blair, Nebraska, grantee herein, and its assigns, the free and uninterrupted use, liberty and privilege of a right of way one foot

in width extending from the North line to the South line and along and contiguous to the East line of Lot 20, Block 39, City of Blair, Nebraska; together with the free use of said way to and for said grantee and its assigns, at all times and seasons for the purpose of laying an electric cable.

To have and to hold all and singular the aforesaid privileges to the proper use and enjoyment by said grantee and assigns as aforesaid.
