AU ORDIFACCE VACATING WEST D STREET EAST OF FORTY-SECOND STRUCT, THAT PORTION OF FORTY-FIRST AVENUE BETWEEN HOWE STREET AND WEST C STREET, AND ALL OF FORTIETH AVENUE BETWEEN HOWE STREET AND WEST C STREET.

Whereas a petition has been filed with the City of Omaha, Belraska, signed by the owners of all of the property abutting upon the atreets hereinafter specifically described, and asking that the said streets so specifically described be vacated, and

Whereas the said streets sought to be vacated are not necessary for public use, and the public convenience and welfare will be promoted and subserved by vacating same, Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Omaha, Neuraska:

Section 1. That the following portions of the hereinafter named Streets within the limits of Thomas and Sears Addition to South Omaha, new in the City of Omaha, Webraska, be and the same are hereby vacated as public streets, to-wit:

All of West D Street within the limits of Thomas and Sears Addition to South Omaha, platted, dedicated and recorded as Brodt, Avenue, and being the portion of West D Street extending from the east side of Forty-Second Street to the east line of said Thomas and Sears Addition.

All of Forty-First Avenue between Howe Street and West C Street.

All of Fortieth Avenue between Howe Street and West C Street.

This ordinance is enacted Section 2. upon the express condition and the parts of streets herein enumerated are vacated upon the express condition that there is reserved to the City of Omaha a perpetual right to lay, construct and maintain in said streets, or any part thereof, sewer pipes either for main sewers or sanitary sewers, water pipes either for supply main or service main. conduits for electric light wires, telegraph or telephone wires, pipes for and through which gas may be conducted either for street lighting purposes or for service of private individuals, and the right to erect and maintain a viaduet or viaduets along or over any of said streets, or parts of streets. And the right of the City of Omaha to go in and upon said streets or parts of streets, and of its agents and representatives to make, maintain, repair or rebuild or re-construct any of said improvements.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in seree and effect from and after fifteen days after its passage.
