I.

I direct that the expenses of my last illness and my funeral expenses, and all my just debts be paid out of my personal property.

II.

The undersigned, as Executrix of said Estate herewith respectfully submits to the Court the following Final Report of her acts and doings from March 22, 1959, to October 30, 1959.

COMES NOW Rose Barna and states unto the Court that she is the duly appointed and acting Executrix of the aforesaid Estate. That she has fully administered said Estate and the same is now ready for final settlement and distribution.

The assets of the Estate are those set forth in the inventory of your Executrix as special Administratrix filed herein on April 15, 1959. All of these assets have been reduced to cash or its equivalents for purposes of settlement and distribution.

The residence, more particularly described as Lot Two (2), in Block Five (5), in Brookline, an addition to the City of Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska, as surveyed, platted and recorded was appraised by all the interested parties at \$10,000.00 and your Executrix believes that no better price can be received. The Will provides that the residence, if possible be sold to the legatees. The sale is further complicated because of the homestead rights of Frank Slama which on a valuation of \$10,000.00 would amount to \$2,620.50, (based on the Formula prescribed by the State of Nebraska for inheritance taxes, and Frank Slama being 71 years of age). To permit the settlement of the Estate, Frank Slama is willing to accept (in addition to the \$1,100.00 already paid on monthly allowances and the \$200.00 personal property exemption,) \$12,500.00 consisting of \$9,000.00 in cash and one \$3,500.00 note due September 1, 1960, received in the sale of the business in full for his share, including homestead rights plus funeral and last illness expenses as hereinafter set forth.

The adult heirs, Rose Barna, George Milacek, Godfrey Milacek and Joseph Milacek have agreed to purchase, share and share alike the aforesaid residence property at a valuation of \$10,000.00, and they will accept such one-fourth interest of \$2,500.00, the same as cash.

By the aforesaid agreements, which in the opinion of the Executrix, are fair and to the advantage of the estate, the sale of the residence for purposes of distribution be considered as cash.

By the terms of the Last Will of the decedent the business and its assets were given one-half to Godfrey Milacek and Joseph Milacek, and the other one-half to Rose Barna, George Milacek and Frank Milacek's two minor children. By the election of Frank Slama, the real value of this bequest of the business was reduced by one-fourth, nevertheless, Godfrey Milacek and Joseph Milacek agreed to purchase the business at the appraised value, and apply their bequest on the purchase price. It was discovered that the inventory appraised at \$30,000.00 was erroneous in that certain monuments aggregating \$637.20 in value had been sold prior to the death of the decedent, so that Godfrey Milacek and Joseph Milacek in conformity to the will purchased the Monument business consisting of the following and at the valuations herein set forth:

cash, their testamentary share of \$11,961.74 and \$14,000.00 in four notes of \$3,500.00 each. But the last of the said \$3,500.00 has now been paid in cash. So that from the sale of the business there was realized as follows:

Your Executrix with the help of Godfrey and Joseph Milacek collected on said accounts the total sum of \$5,739.04: It appeared that it would take a long time and great expense to realize any substantial sum of the remaining accounts aggregating \$2,681.12, they appear very slow, doubtful and some likely uncollectible. Your Executrix after consulting the interested heirs and legatees sold such remaining accounts to Godfrey and Joseph Milacek for the

sum of \$800.00 as they appeared in a better position to realize something on said accounts. Your Executrix states by way of summary that she received for the Estate the following and that the same is the entire estate of the decedent. For purposes of distribution it may all be considered as cash since the adult heirs are willing to accept the notes received on the sale of the business and the residence to be sold to the heirs as cash on their distributive shares.

Your executrix states that in truth, the estate paid the funeral bills, doctor bills and such other items probably chargeable to Frank Slama, the husband (White vs. White 150 Nebraska 167) these items aggregate \$2,088.30. Frank Slama has agreed to assume these and they will be repaid from his share. Hence in this report they are treated as though not paid out by the Executrix because these moneys will be refunded by Frank Slama. Frank Slama has agreed to accept in full \$12,500.00 (\$3,500.00 in a note and \$9,000.00 in cash, in addition to the aforesaid sum of \$2,088.30 (which he will then return to Estate) or a total of \$14,588.30.

This amount which he is willing to accept is less than his statutory share and your Executive, the adult heirs, and the Guardian of the minor heirs are agreeable that Frank Slama's share would be greater if distribution were

Your Executrix states that in the handling of the Estate she at all times consulted with the adult heirs and with Elinor Milacek, mother and

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Guardian of Joan Mialcek and Frank Milacek, Jr., minor children of Frank Milacek, deceased. They were at all times fully informed of the status of the Estate. All sales made by her were by them approved. That under the Will she is required to sell the residence and that the price at which the adult heirs are willing to accept it is a fair price and very probably more than could be obtained in a public sale.

That the court approve her proposed sale of the residence at \$10,000.00 to the four adult heirs as hereinbefore set forth and that the shares of each heir and legatee be determined and ordered paid, either in cash or in property as the adult heirs are willing to accept payment in property as hereinbefore set out.

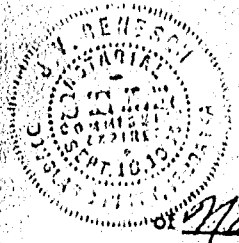

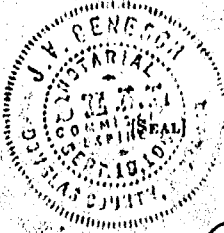

ORDER DETERMINING
INHERITANCE TAXES

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This matter came on for hearing on this 2nd day of December, 1959, pursuant to an Order issued herein to determine the value of the Estate of the decedent for purposes of Inheritance and Estate Taxes. The County Attorney of Douglas County, Nebraska, John J. Hanley, was duly notified and the Executrix of the Estate served upon him a proper notice and a detailed report showing the taxable property of the decedent.

The Court finds that the total value of the Estate at the time of death was \$64,961.20 and the proper allowable deductions were \$12,429.84, leaving a net estate of \$52,531.36.

Frank Slama had a homestead interest in the sum of \$2,620.50 which left subject to computing his succession interest as surviving spouse in the amount of \$49,910.86. Frank Slama was decedent's second husband and the father of none of her children and hence entitled to a succession interest of one-fourth, or \$12,477.71 plus his homestead interest. His share from the Estate is less than the aforesaid above amounts. In addition thereto, he has an exemption of \$10,000.00. Hence no tax is due on his share.

The remainder of the Estate goes to the four children and two grandchildren. The share of each of these is less than their exemption of \$10,000.00. Hence no Inheritance Taxes are due on the share of any of them.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, that no Inheritance Taxes are due from this Estate or from any of the heirs and beneficiaries herein.


