## BOOK 588 PAGE 535 EASEMENT AND RIGHT OF WAY

THIS INDENTURE, made this Alday of Cotalia.

197 7, between Burton Christopherson and Pearl M. Christopherson husband and wife, hereinafter referred to as "Grantors", and Metropolitan Utilities District of Omaha, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Grantee", WITNESSETH:

That the Grantors, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant to Metropolitan Utilities District of Omaha, its successors and assigns, an easement and right of way to lay, maintain, operate, repair, relay and remove, at any time, pipelines for the transportation of gas and water and all appurtenances thereto, together with the right of ingress and egress to and from the same, on, over and through lands described as follows:

Several strips of land lying in lots 2, 3, 4, and 10 of Fort Crest Commercial Plaza as now platted and recorded in Douglas County, Nebraska, said strips being more particularly described as follows:

A strip of land lying in lot 2 being five feet wide lying along and parallel to the right of way line of Ellison Circle. Said strip being all that portion of lot 2 lying within five feet of said right of way line.

A strip of land lying in lot 3 being five feet wide lying along and parallel to the right of way line of Ellison Circle. Said strip being all that portion of lot 3 lying within five feet of said right of way line.

A strip of land lying in lot 4 being five feet wide lying along and parallel to the right of way line of Ellison Circle. Said strip extending northerly from the southerly property line of said lot a distance of fifty nine and seventy four hundredths (59.74) feet, said distance measured along said right of way line.

A strip of land lying in lot 10 being five feet wide lying along and parallel to the right of way line of Ellison Circle. Said strip being all that portion of lot 10 lying within five feet of said right of way line.

These strips contain a total of 0.03 acres, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said easement and right of way unto the said Grantee Metropolitan Utilities District of Omaha, its successors and assigns.

- 1. The Grantors agree that neither they nor their heirs or assigns will at any time erect, construct or place on or below the surface of said tract of land any building or structure, except pavement, and that they will not give anyone else permission to do so.
- 2. Grantee shall restore the surface of the soil excavated for any purpose hereunder, as near as may be reasonably possible, to the original contour thereof and as soon after such work is performed as may be reasonably possible to do so.
- 3. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as a waiver of any rights of Grantors, or duties and powers of the Grantee respecting the ownership, use, operations, extensions and connections to any gas main and/or water main constructed and maintained hereunder.
