PROVIDED, first, that in so doing said Iowa, Service Company, its representatives or assigns shall not in any way damage said premises nor any vegetation, shrubs, trees or other property now on said premises, or any vegetation shrubs, trees or other property which may hereafter be placed thereon. PROVIDED, second, that said company or its representatives shall not trim any trees or shrubs on said premises save and except those that may be necessary to keep the said line clear and unobstructed for the purpose of rendering electric service which privilege company shall have under the direction of myself or my estate.

PROVIDED, third, that if said poles or other lines are so located as to interfere with any improvement hereafter placed on said premises, said company or its successors, at their own expense, shall make such removals or changes in said electric poles and transmission lines as are necessary to clear and remove such interference but in event of any such change or re-location of electric equipment, and lines an alternative route along the aforesaid premises shall be given to electric company the relocated line to be placed so as not to interfere with the aforesaid improvements.

PROVIDED, fourth, that if said company or its successors shall at any time fail to comply with any of the provisions of this permit, all permission herein granted shall cease and be thereby revoked.
