ORDINANCE NO. 1376

An Ordinance declaring the necessity of appropriating an easement ever, upon and through Tax Lot 5 in the Southwest 1/4 of Section 9-14-13; for the purpose of constructing, repairing and maintaining through the City of Omaha, and providing for the appointment of three disinterested freeholders of said city, to assess the damages to the owners of and persons interested in property over, upon and through which an easement is proposed to be appropriated.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That is is proper and necessary; and it is hereby declared proper and necessary to appropriate an easement over, upon and through Tax Lot 5 in the Southwest 1/4, Section 9-14-13 for the use of the City of Omaha for the purpose of constructing, repairing and maintaining Stand Sever No. 1011 of the City of Omaha; said easement to be five feet on each side of the following described center-line and through the following property; to-wit: Tax Lot 5 in the Southwest 1/4; Section 9-14-13. Reginning at a point on the North property line of Jefferson Street 472.5 -feet West of the West property line of 30th Street, said point being also on the South Line of Tax Lot 5, Section 9-14-13; thence North, and parallel to the West property line of 30th Street between Jefferson Street and "Y" Street, 620 feet to the point of curve; thence continuing on a curve to the right, whose radius is 131.11 feet and whose central angle is 410-431, 95.46 feet to the end of the curve 707.32 feet North of the South line of Tax Lot 5, Section 9-14-13 and 439.23 feet West of West property line of 30th Street; thence continuing on a straight line in a northeasterly direction 59.86 feet to a point 752.0 feet North of the South line of Tax Lot 5; Section 9-14-13 and 399.39 feet West of the West property line of 30th Street.



1. Grant of Easement. KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Magic City Realty Company,

Magic City Realty Co. in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and the several covenants and

to agreements hereinafter set out, does hereby grant, convey and confirm

City of Omaha unto the City of Omaha an easement and the right to construct and

maintain a main sewer of such dimensions as the City of Omaha may find and determine to be

necessary, over, upon and through Tax Lot Five (5) in the South-west quarter (SW1) of Section

Nine (9), Township Fourteen (14), North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the 6th Principal Meridian;

the center line of which said sewer is more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North property line of Jefferson Street 472.5 feet West of the West property line of 30th Street, said point being also on the South Line of Tax Lot 5, Section 9-14-13; thence North, and parallel to the West property line of 30th Street between Jefferson Street and "Y" Street, 620 feet to the point of curve; thence continuing on a curve to the right, whose radius is 131.11 feet and whose central angle is 41°-43', 95.46 feet to the end of the curve 707.32 feet North of the South line of Tax Lot 5, Section 9-14-13 and 439.23 feet West of West property line of 30th Street; thence continuing on a straight line in a northeasterly direction 59.86 feet to a point 752.0 feet North of the South line of Tax Lot 5,

The further considerations hereinabove referred to are as follows:

Section 9-14-13 and 399.39 feet West of the West property line of 30th Street.

- 1. The condition that if any changes, repairs or alterations are necessary to be made at any time, or if any portion of said sewer or the whole thereof shall be reconstructed after the lots into which said property may be hereafter divided are filled or improved, the said City of Cmaha shall pay to the owner or owners of such lot or lots any and all damages that may be occasioned by the repairing, altering or reconstruction of said sewer or occasioned by the failure of the said City of Omaha to keep said sewer in repair or occasioned by the failure of the said City of Omaha to construct said sewer of such size and dimensions and in such manner as to perform the work and services for which said sewer shall have been constructed; the damages that may be occasioned to include damage to crops, vines, gardens and lawns, but such description of damages shall not be considered exclusive of any and all other damages that may be occasioned to the owners of said lot or lots by the City of Omaha, its agents or employees, due to or growing out of the construction of the sewer aforesaid.
- 2. The said City of Omaha further agrees to give to the grantor herein without charge or expense such storm water connections with said sewer as the said grantor may desire, and also

one sanitary connection with said sewer at such point as the grantor shall designate.

- 3. The grantee hereby further agrees that for any additional sanitary connections required by the grantor, permits to construct same will be issued at a cost not to exceed One Dollar (\$1.00) per lineal front foot, and permit will be issued for each 40 feet if desired by the grantor.
- The City of Omaha hereby agrees to hold the grantor herein harmless from any loss or liability growing out of the claim of any person or persons whomsoever for damages alleged to be suffered by reason of the construction or repair of said sewer on the premises above described.
