PARCEL I:

Lots 1 and 2, Block 225, City of Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska together with the N_2 of vacated alley adjoining said Lots 1 and 2 on the South, and the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of vacated 15th Street adjoining said Lot 1 on the West.

All that part of Lots 7 and 8 in Block 225, in the City of Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of said Lot 8; thence southerly along the east line of said Lot 8 a distance of 37.15 feet to a point thereon; thence southwesterly along a curve to the left, having a radius of 2817.97 feet, and which is tangent at its point of beginning to a straight line that forms an angle from south to southwest of 47° 26' 23"with said east line of Lot 8, a distance of 136.69 feet to a point in the south line of said Lot 7, that is 33.6 feet distant east from the southwest corner thereof, measured along said south line; thence westerly along the south line of said Lot 7, which is a straight line that forms an angle from southwest to west of 45° 20' 23" with a straight line drawn tangent to the end of the last described curve, a distance of 33.6 feet to the southwest corner of said Lot 7; thence northerly along the west line of said Lot 7 a distance of 132 feet to the northwest corner thereof; thence easterly along the north line of said Lots 7 and 8, a distance of 132 feet to the point of beginning; together with the South 1/2 of vacated alley adjoining said Lots 7 and 8 on the north and that portion of the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of vacated 15th Street adjoining that part of said Lot 8 on the east.

PARCEL II:

Lot 4, Block 224, in the Original City of Omaha, together with East ½ of vacated 15th Street adjoining on the West and the South 10' of vacated Marcy Street adjoining on the North, in Douglas County, Nebraska, except that portion thereof taken for Union Pacific Railroad Right of WAY.
