ATTORNMENT AND NONDISTURBANCE AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT between E. J. Brandeis Trust ("Trust") and The Southroads Bank ("Bank").

- (1) In the event of the termination, cancellation or expiration of Underlying Lease or foreclosure of the Leasehold Mortgages, or either of them, for any reason whatsoever while Bank Lease is still in effect, the premises demised by Baer to Bank shall be subject to the Bank Lease as fully and effectually as if Baer had been the owner of the fee of the premised demised in Underlying Lease at the time of the execution and delivery of Bank Lease.
 - (2) Simultaneously with such termination, cancellation or expiration of Underlying Lease or foreclosure of the Leasehold Mortgages, or either of them, the Bank Lease shall take effect as a lease of the premises demised therein, together with all of the rights and privileges therein contained, between Trust, as landlord therein, and Bank, as tenant therein, for the balance of the term of Bank (as the same may have been or may thereafter be extended in accordance with its terms) upon all the terms, covenants, provisions and conditions therein contained, Trust covenanting and agreeing to be bound by the provisions of the Bank Lease, and Bank covenanting and agreeing to be bound by and to perform and observe all of the obligations imposed by Bank Lease upon the tenant therein.
 - (3) The provisions of this agreement shall be selfexecuting and shall take effect without the execution of any further instrument, lease or agreement.

LEASE DESCRIPTION
