THIS DEED, made this <u>30.th</u> day of <u>November</u>, 1965, by and between the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, hereinafter referred to as the DEPARTMENT, and the DEPARTMENT OF ROADS, STATE OF NEBRASKA, hereinafter referred to as the STATE:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Department of Roads, State of Nebraska, has filed application under the provisions of the Act of Congress of August 27, 1958 (Title 23, United States Code, Section 317, 72 Stat. 916) for a right-of-way, including the control of access over certain lands hereinafter described, situated in Douglas County, Nebraska, and being a part of the lands of the Two Rivers Nursery property, under the control and jurisdiction of the General Services Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administrator, pursuant to delegation of authority from the Secretary of Commerce, has determined that the interests in lands covered by the application are reasonably necessary for a right-of-way in connection with the construction of Nebraska Federal-aid Highway Project F-78(11); and

WHEREAS, the Administrator of General Services has authorized the Department to transfer the lands to the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Department as authorized by law, and in compliance with all requirements imposed by or pursuant to Part 8 of Subtitle A of Commerce and Foreign Trade Regulations (15 C.F.R., Part 8) pertaining to and effectuating the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252; 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4), does hereby appropriate, remise, release, quitclaim and convey unto the State of Nebraska the lands described in Exhibit "A" and shown on Exhibit "B", both attached hereto and made parts hereof, together with all existing, future or potential common law or statutory abutters' rights or easements of access to, from and between the right-of-way of the public identified as Nebraska Federal-aid Highway Project F-78(11) and all the adjoining property of the United States of America, as set forth in said Exhibit "A" and delineated on said Exhibit "B".

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the above-mentioned lands unto the State of Nebraska, for so long as such is needed for highway purposes, upon the express condition that if, at any time, the need for highway purposes

shall no longer exist, notice of the fact shall be given by the State to the Department and such lands shall immediately revert to the United States and to the control of the General Services Administration, as such control existed prior to this instrument; and subject to the covenants, conditions, restrictions and reservations herein contained as follows, which shall remain in effect for the period during which said real property and structures thereon are used for a purpose for which Federal assistance is extended or for another purpose involving the provision of similar services or benefits and shall be binding on the State, its successors and assigns:

- 1. The State, in consideration of the conveyance of said lands and interests in land, does hereby covenant and agree for itself, its successors and assigns that (a) no members of the traveling public and business users of the federally-assisted highway shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in their access to and use of said highway or their access to and use of the facilities and services provided for public accommodations (such as eating, sleeping, rest, recreation, and vehicle servicing) constructed on, over, or under the right-of-way of the highway constructed upon the land hereby conveyed, (b) that the State shall use the said lands and interests in land so conveyed, in compliance with all other requirements imposed pursuant to said Part 8 of Subtitle A of Commerce and Foreign Trade Regulations and as said Regulations may be amended.
- 2. That in the event of breach of any of the above-mentioned nondiscrimination conditions, the Department shall have the right to re-enter said land and facilities on said land, and the above-described lands and interests in land shall thereupon revert to the United States of America and to the control of the General Services Administration, as such control existed prior to this instrument.
