Now, on this 7th day of July, 1958, this case came on to be heard upon the Application to Determine Inheritance Taxes, Final Report and Petition for Discharge of Jay Kersbergen, Administrator of the Estate of Walter J. McVicker, Deceased, and the evidences, and the Administrator having appeared, and no one to oppose, the matter was submitted to the Court, on consideration whereof the Court finds:

That on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1958, Jay Kersbergen, Administrator of the Estate of Walter J. McVicker, Deceased, filed in this Court his final administration account as such Administrator, and a petition praying that said account be settled and allowed, and that said estate be distributed and assigned to such persons as are by law entitled thereto, and that he be discharged from his trust as such Administrator.

That due notice of the time set for hearing has been duly given and published as required by law and the order of this Court, as aforesaid, and that voluntary appearances and waivers of notice of all persons appearing to have a direct legal interest in this estate, have been filed.

The Court further finds that the time limited for the presentation of claims against said estate has long since expired, and that judgment on claims has been entered therein, and have been fully paid and that all claims allowed have been paid and satisfied in full.

That the final administration account, as filed herein, is in all respects true and correct.

That said decedent, Walter J. McVicker, died seized of certain interests in real estate, including the following: none

WHEREFORE, IT IS CONSIDERED AND ADJUDGED BY THE COURT:

That all claims not heretofore presented against the said estate be, and they hereby are, forever barred.

That the final account of the said Administrator, stated as aforesaid, is allowed and approved.

That the following administration expenses are hereby allowed and ordered paid, to-wit:

It is further ordered and adjudged that all of the decedent's property of whatsoever kind and wheresoever located, including the above described real estate, be, and the same is hereby assigned in fee simple, as follows:



An undivided one-third share to each of the following:

Della McVicker, widow,  
Graham D. McVicker, son, and  
Donald E. McVicker, son.

That the estate of Walter J. McVicker, Deceased, was not of sufficient value to be subject to Federal Estate Tax, and that the shares of the heirs-at-law are not of sufficient value to be subject to State Inheritance Tax, and that said estate is not subject to any unpaid Gift Tax.

The Court further finds, on personal examination of the files, that there has been filed with the Court receipts for all disbursements and payments made and as contained in said final report; the purpose of this finding is to have a record made so in case of the said receipts is lost from the files, no objection can be made to said estate proceeding.

That upon the payment of the costs of administration, as aforesaid, and upon the return of the proper vouchers therefor, and upon the approval of the same by this Court, the said Jay Kersbergen, Administrator, will be discharged from any further liability herein, and his administrator's bond cancelled, and his bondsman discharged and released.
