AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 11th day of October, 1966, by and between Williams Brothers Pipe Line Company, a Delaware Corporation, with its principal office in Kansas City, Missouri, hereinafter termed "Company", and Mobil Oil Corporation, a New York Corporation, having an office in Kansas City, Missouri, hereinafter termed "Mobil",

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Company owns certain rights of way for pipe lines and appurtenances on, over, under, and across a defined strip of land in the south 200 feet of Lot "T" of Commercial Lot 1282 in La Vista, a subdivision of Sarpy County, Nebraska, according to the recorded plat thereof, which strip of land is more particularly described in that certain agreement dated February 1, 1963, and filed for record in Book 31 of Miscellaneous at Page 399 in the office of the Register of Deeds of said Sarpy County, Nebraska, and

WHEREAS, Mobil has requested permission to construct two concrete entrance ways and asphalt service drives, install electrical conduit, and add an earth fill on, over, and across Company's right of way in the aforesaid south 200 feet of Lot "T" of Commercial Lot 1282, La Vista Addition,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and in consideration of one dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Company hereby permits construction of the above service drives, installation of electrical conduit, and the addition of earth fill on, over, and across the aforesaid right of way, such permission to be conditioned upon and subject to the following:

1. Mobil is to notify Company no less than 48 hours before work on the right of way begins.
2. The minimum of 24 inches be maintained between bottom of base course of all concrete and asphalt paving and top of Company's existing pipe lines.
3. All electrical conduit be placed a minimum of 24 inches
