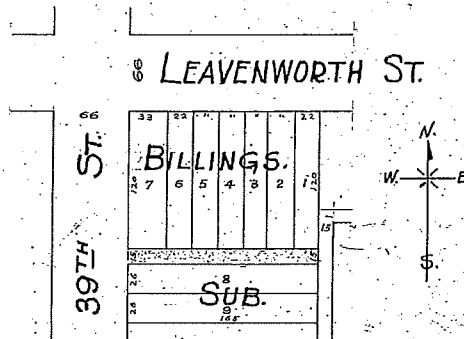

WHEREAS, Said property owners have in and by said petition waived any and all damages that may be occasioned by the vacating of said alley,

THEREFORE,

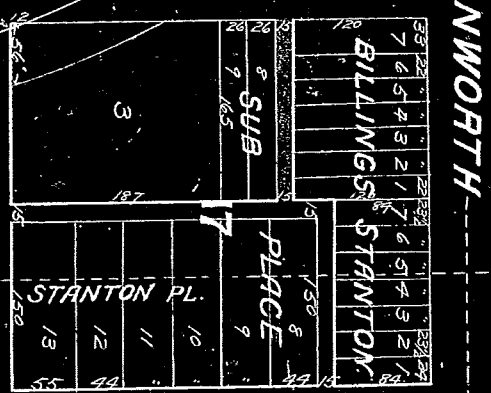
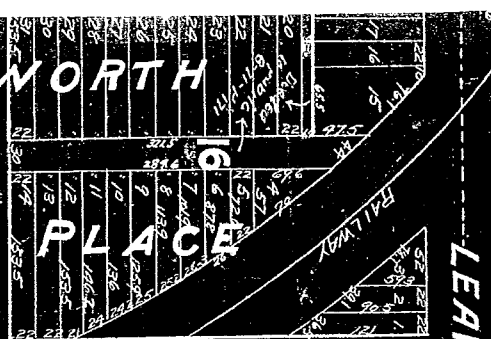
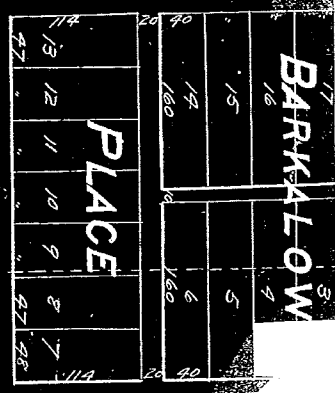
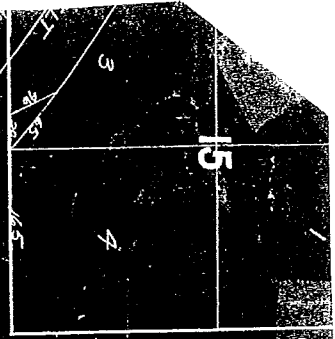
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That East and West alley between Leavenworth and Marcy Streets from 39th Street to first alley East of 39th Street in the City of Omaha be, and the same is hereby vacated; the City of Omaha reserving the right, however, to grant permits for the construction of pole lines with the necessary lateral connections along said alley; and also the right to construct sewer, water mains, conduits and any other sub-surface structures which may be found necessary for properly serving abutting property.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force after fifteen days from and after its passage.
