- AN ORDINANCE vacating East/West alley between Izard Street and Nicholas Street from 19th Street (Florence Boulevard) to 20th Street in the City of Omaha and providing the effective date hereof.
- WHEREAS, petition representing owners of more than 75 percent of the property abutting on the East/West alley between Izard Street and Nicholas Street from 19th Street (Florence Boulevard) to 20th Street has been filed with the City of Omaha; and,
- WHEREAS, said property owners have in and by said petition waived any and all damages that may be occasioned by said vacation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That the East/West alley between Izard Street and Nicholas Street from 19th Street (Florence Boulevard) to 20th Street abutted by Lots 1 through 8, inclusive and vacated 19th Street adjacent, Block 195 1/2, Omaha City located in the Southwest Quarter Section 5-15-13

be, and hereby is, vacated; the vacating of the property herein described, and the reversion thereof, pursuant to applicable law, shall be subject to the conditions and limitation that there is reserved to the Metropolitan Utilities District of the City of Omaha or any other public utility to construct, maintain, repair or renew and operate now existing or hereafter installed pipes, mains, pole lines, conduits, wires and other similar services and equipment and appurtenances above, on and below the surface of the ground for the purpose of serving the general public or abutting property; and the right so reserved shall also include such lateral connection or branch lines as may be ordered, desired or permitted by the City or such other utility and to enter upon the premises to accomplish the There is also reserved the above purposes at any and all times. right of the Union Pacific Railroad Company to operate, maintain, repair and renew trackage existing or other trackage within the vacated alley. All vegetation upon the premises, including but not limited to, buildings, walls, fences, drives and walks, may be damaged in the exercise of the rights herein reserved without compensation to any person, except, railroad trackage described above.
