

City Ordinance No. 26

An ordinance to vacate and set apart to the Union Pacific Railroad company a strip of ground, Thirty Three feet in width from S. to P streets and on the west side of Twenty seventh street and the County Road or Depot grounds and other improvements in the city of south Omaha Nebraska  
Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the city of south Omaha Nebraska

That a strip of ground Thirty Three feet in width off the west side of Twenty Seventh street and county road from S. to P streets is hereby vacated and set apart to the Union Pacific Railroad company for their use.

Provided said company shall erect and maintain a Passenger Depot on the north line of N. street and not to exceed sixty feet north of the north line of N. street within the city of south Omaha Nebraska.
