of Eight Hundred Sixty-one and 50/100 Dollars to us in hand paid by Papillion Drainage District, second party, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey into said second party, its successors or assigns, all that certain tract, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Douglas and State of Nebraska, and described as follows to-wit:

A strip of piece of land one hundred feet wide, being fifty feet wide on each side of the center line of the cut-off ditch, drainage ditch, or levee, each or all as the case may be as the same is now surveyed, and located by second party, and extending across from the west side of the northeast quarter of southwest quarter of section one, to the east side of northeast quarter of northeast quarter of section twelve, all in township fourteen range eleven, containing twelve and one-tenth acres, together with any and all desired access thereto by said Drainage District, its agents, contractors, representatives and employees across other portions of said land of first parties, under reasonable conditions prescribed by party of the first part.
