

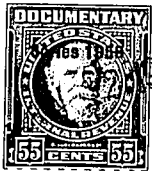
This Indenture, Made this 28<sup>th</sup> day of October

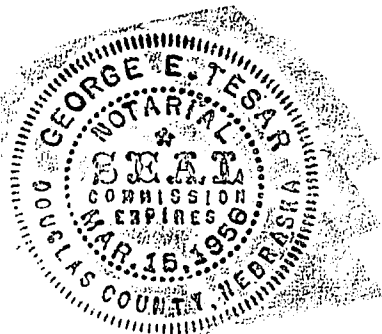
