

WARRANTY DEED (DOUGLAS COUNTY FORM)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, KENNETH D. HALLEEN and LEATRICE M. HALLEEN, husband and wife,

the following described real estate, situate in the County of Douglas and State of Nebraska, to-wit: That part of Lot 5, Block 7, Benson, now a part of the City of Omaha, as surveyed, platted and recorded, lying North of a line described as follows: Beginning on the West line of Lot 5, 18 feet South of the Northwest corner of Lot 5, and extending Easterly to a point on the East line of Lot 5, 19 feet South of the Northeast corner of said Lot 5

HALLEEN, husband and wife, for ourselves and our heirs, executors, and administrators, do covenant with said CITY OF OMAHA, a Municipal Corporation, and with its successors heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized of said premises, that they are free from encumbrance.

and that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same and that we will and our heirs, executors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same unto the said CITY OF OMAHA, a Municipal Corporation, and its successors heirs and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
