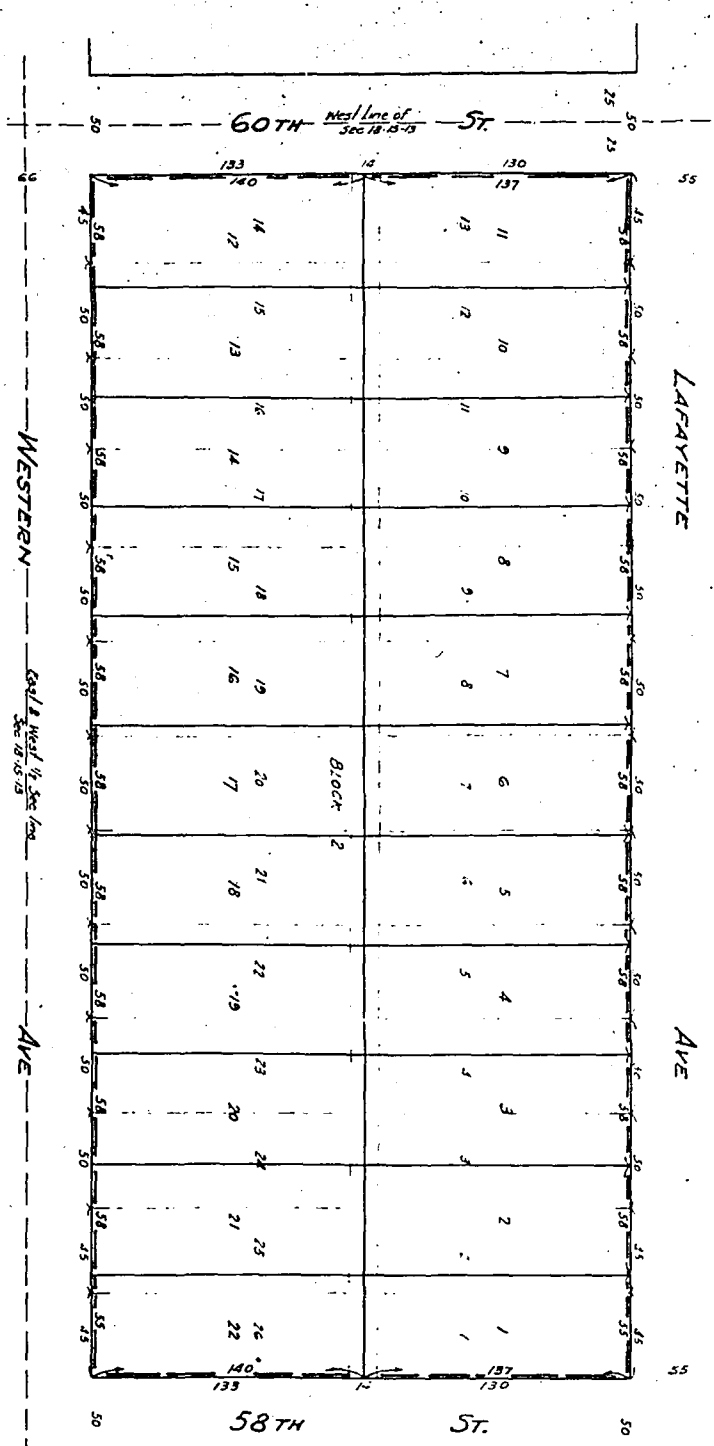


DILLON'S 9TH ADDITION
