

Permission to farm R. O. W.

Whereas, I, Harriet C. Page of Saline
 County, and State of Nebraska owner of
 the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Thir-
 teen (13) in Township Eight (8) North of Range
 One (1) East of the 6th P. M., in the County of

Saline and State of Nebraska, am now occupying, a portion of the right of way
 of the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company (Grantee and Assignee of the
 Burlington & Missouri River Railroad Company in Nebraska), over and across
 said land; and Whereas, said Railroad Company hereby agrees to permit me,
 in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and the covenants hereinafter
 contained, to occupy that part of said right of way not lying or being within
 fifty (50) feet of the center line of its main track, for a time, to be used for agri-
 cultural purposes only, and provided no right shall inure antagonistic to the rights
 of said Railroad Company to its right of way so occupied; and provided further, that said
 Railroad Company shall have the right under this agreement to retake immediate
 possession of said right of way, to be occupied by me, at any time: Now Therefore,
 I do hereby agree for myself, my heirs and assigns, that said land is occupied
 by me by permission of said Railroad Company, and that I will not claim for
 myself, my heirs or assigns, any right, title or interest to any portion of said
 land so occupied except such rights as are given under this instrument.
