ORDINANCE NO. 108

AN ORDINANCE CREATING PAVING DISTRICT NO. 1973-1 OF UNION, NEBRASKA, AND ORDERING THE CONSTRUCTION OF STREET IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF UNION, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is created in the Village of Union, Nebraska, a paving district to be known and designated as Paving District No. 1973-1 of the Village of Union, Nebraska.

Section 2. That the limits, boundaries and improvements to be made in Paving District No. 1973-1 are defined and established as follows:

Beginning at the NE corner of Lot 12, Block 1, Banning Addition to Village of Union, thence West to the NW corner of Lot 7, Block 1, original Town of Union; thence continuing West approximately 200 feet to centerline of M.P.R.R.; thence S. 18° 59'E along centerline of M.P.R.R. for 375 feet; thence East to the NW corner of Lot 10, Block 1, South Union; thence continuing East to the NE corner of Lot 21, Block 2, South Union; thence continuing East for 749 feet; thence North to the point of beginning,

and within which District Main Street from the Missouri Pacific Rail Road right-of-way shall be improved by widening, paving with integral curb and gutter and the Village will construct or reconstruct pedestrian walks on each side of the street from the Missouri Pacific Rail Road right-of-way line to 2nd Street, including all necessary appurtenances in connection therewith.

Section 3. Said street shall be improved and said improvements shall be made in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates prepared by the special engineer employed by the Village and to be approved by the Board of Trustees.

Section 4. Notice of the creation of said district shall be published as provided by law in the Roller's Journal, a legal newspaper published in Cass County and of general circulation in said Village, and in addition a copy of said notice shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, to all owners of property in the District subject to assessment who are nonresidents of the Village of Union, Nebraska.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be posted in three public places in the Village and take effect according to law.
