 Block One, W. of South Union, Nebraska. Six (6) inches off the West Side of
 the South Sixty Five, (65), feet of Lot One (1), in Block One, W. of South Union,
 Nebraska. According to the recorded plat there is. The six inches off the
 West side of the South Sixty Five feet of Lot One is deeded for the
 express purpose for use as a party wall between the said Lots
